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Halong Bay – Paloma Junk - 3 days / 2 nights

Day 1:

You are picked up from your hotel at 8.00am and arrive at Halong Bay wharf at 11.45am, where you will be met by our crew who will escort you on board the Paloma Junk and serve welcome drinks.

You then check into your cabin and we begin cruising into Halong Bay. A fresh seafood lunch is served in the restaurant or on the outdoor dining area while you enjoy the stunning views of the Bay. In the early afternoon we arrive at Vong Vieng floating fishing village and drop anchor. Our guide will give you some information and interesting facts about this fascinating village and its local community. We disembark and travel on the sampans rowed by the local people. They will be your guides through their fishing village where you can meet the locals, visit the school and pearl farms. See first-hand what life is like living on the water.

Back on board we head for the calm waters of the lagoons and beaches for swimming and relaxing on deck or pamper yourself with a massage and sauna in our luxurious spa. (*Optional kayaking*) Enjoy a great sunset dinner, and spend a relaxing evening on board the Paloma Junk maybe fishing and drinking Vietnamese wine.

Day2:

For the early risers join us for a Tai Chi session on the sun deck or take the opportunity to have an early morning swim and enjoy the beauty of a Halong Bay sunrise. After breakfast we transfer from The Paloma to a smaller boat which will take you to one of the more remote and secluded parts of the Lan Ha Bay waters and islands. Our guide will take you on a kayaking tour of the waters to discover the lagoons with the coral reefs and beaches or you can just sunbathe and swim on one of the secluded beaches. A special BBQ lunch is served on the private beach (Weather permitting). (*Optional kayaking*)

Around 4pm you return to the Paloma to enjoy the sunset with evening cocktails and fresh fruit. Dinner is served in the early evening in the restaurant or outdoor dining area

Day3:

For the early risers join us for a Tai Chi session on the sun deck or take the opportunity to have an early morning swim and enjoy the beauty of a Halong Bay sunrise. After breakfast we set sail for Bo Hon Island. Disembark and visit (Sung Sot) Surprise Cave. It is one of the largest grottoes in Halong Bay with thousands of stalactites and stalagmites.

An early lunch is made available to enjoy while we head back to Halong wharf on another scenic route. We arrive back at the wharf at 12 noon for our drive back to your hotel in Hanoi arriving at 4.30pm.

Tour includes: Guide and transport from and returning to your hotel, all meals and accommodation, Tai Chi, kayaking, and national park entrance fees.

What's not included in your tour: Personal expenses.
